What is ABA therapy?

Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) is an evidence-based practice that uses the principles of reinforcement to teach new skills and help people communicate their wants and needs.

Many use ABA therapy to reduce challenging behaviors. At Advantage Autism, we believe that all behavior is communication and we want to help your child communicate in ways that avoid harm and are more understandable to others.

But don't think this is only for your child! As caregivers, it is important for you to understand those wants and needs. Parent trainings are just as vital to progress as those 1:1 sessions with your child.

Enrollment Process

After initial paperwork is completed, we will verify benefits with your insurance carrier and review a financial agreement. Advantage Autism is currently in-network with United Healthcare, Blue Cross Blue Shield, and Medicaid- IME, Iowa Total Care and Amerigroup. We also accept private pay.

We will then sit down for a comprehensive interview around your family's needs- strengths, areas for growth, and any concerns. A skill-based assessment will be completed and reviewed. Finally, we will come together to develop a plan to meet the identified goals.

Assent and Self-Advocacy

Assent is the act of agreeing to engage in an activity. Parents consent to services for their child, but children assent to those services through their behavior and/or language.

Assent and self-advocacy are at the forefront of our mission at Advantage Autism. We think it is an essential skill to be able to speak up for yourself and for what you need. So, we will be teaching and honoring assent and the withdrawal of assent, no matter the age!

How long do services last?

Depending on the needs of your family, services typically occur 2-3 times per week for 1-2 hours each. Authorization periods last 6 months, but Advantage Autism will continue with services until goals are met or you feel we aren't needed any longer. More discussion on this will occur upon intake.
